A cookie is a small text file that your browser saves on your computer's hard drive. We only use cookies that are strictly necessary and required for our websites to function properly. We also use analytical cookies to anonymously record the behavior of visitors on our website, which includes mouse clicks, scrolls and clicks. This allows us to track how the website is used to further improve it.

Cookies on Megabank.nl

Megabank requests your browser to save cookies on your computer, tablet or mobile phone that are strictly necessary for the functioning of Megabank; for example cookies to ensure that you can retrieve information quickly. Or to allow you to use a service you have explicitly asked for, such as the cookie that remembers your cookie settings.

| Session cookies | Enables you to use Megabank easily | After logon, during session only | Session cookies allow Megabank to recognize and remember you during your visit. |
| Authentication method cookie | Allows you to access Megabank in your preferred way | 75 days | This cookie remembers the authentication method you last used to log on to Megabank. |
| Authentication cookie | Allows you to easily access Megabank | 75 days | This cookie remembers the user ID you last used to log on to Megabank. |
